

Programs & Activities

Orange Beach Public Library offers both year-round and seasonal programs for children of all ages.

Ongoing Programs

Pre-school Storytime

Tuesday, 10am -- year-round.

While the program is designed for pre-schoolers, all ages are welcome - birth and up. Storytime usually lasts an hour or less and all children must be accompanied by a parent/caregiver. Each weekly program begins with songs or games in which all participate. These are followed by a story (either read or told), and the program ends with a craft project on which children work individually or with their caregiver.

Summer Reading Family Program

Thursday, 2pm -- June

Open to all ages, these programs generally last an hour and feature either a guest entertainer or an activity. Parents are encouraged to attend with their children.

Summer Reading Young Adult Program

Thursday, 3pm -- June

Open to children in grades six and up, these programs last about an hour and feature discussion or activity related to the annual Summer Reading Program theme.
